

Parental Involvement Policy Majestic Elementary 2017-2018

In accordance with Federal Law [20 U. S. C. 6318(b), (c), (e)], Majestic Elementary has developed and distributed this parental involvement policy,

- Majestic Elementary will convene an annual meeting at our Meet-the-Teacher event to inform all parents of the school's participation in the Title 1 program and their right to be involved.
 - This meeting will be advertised on the school website, school Facebook, and Skylert messages sent out in English and Spanish to parents/guardians.
 - A letter will be sent out to parents with the same information for parents unable to attend.
- A Title I Leadership Team has been established which includes parents, certified staff, and classified staff. This committee will meet at least quarterly, to review, revise, and discuss progress of this policy and of the Title 1 plan that they developed.
- Parents will be informed of curriculum used in the school, academic assessments used to measure student progress, and expected grade level proficiency standards in classroom disclosure statements sent home the first week of the school year.
 - Updates will be given at Academic Parent Teacher Team events.
- Parents will receive materials and training on how best to work with their students to improve their achievement in the following ways:
 - Three Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT) evening events focusing on math and language arts.
 - Receive monthly school-wide Jordan School District Title 1 newsletters that include tips on how to assist students with learning.
 - Classroom home notes, trackers, and journals.
- Majestic Elementary will coordinate with the Jordan Family Literacy Center, Jordan Parent Advocates, as well as other community agencies, as deemed appropriate.
- Majestic Elementary will provide critical written home communication in Spanish and English. We will also provide Spanish interpreting services, to the extent feasible.

Majestic Elementary is committed to providing clear and frequent communication to parents, and opportunities for families to participate in student achievement and other school activities.
