3. Kathe gave a brief school update on things for the GALA

We also need to put up the "Where are they Now?" bulletin board outside the lunchroom. Mary will order black butcher paper for bulletin board backing. She will also get gold paper for stars and a red carpet runner.

  - b. We should have it posted in the neighborhood facebook pages.
  - c. Orders need to be counted and submitted by 2/28 or 3/2. We will get together at noon on the 28th to count all the money. Look at ideas for entertaining kids during this time.
  - d. Products should arrive the week of 3/9. We will need to meet to divide up the orders before Parent Teacher Conferences on the 11th. We will discuss when to do this at our next meeting.
