

Majestic Elementary SCC Meeting Minutes April 2nd, 2020

1. Kathe welcomed everyone to the meeting. She explained that we have approximately \$27,000 in Land Trust Funds that we need to decide how to spend. She went on to explain how Majestic made a dramatic increase on RISE Science proficiency. Science RISE proficiency score increased from the previous school year from 28.9% to 41.7%. English Language Arts proficiency increased 3.8%. Mathematics proficiency increased 3.7%. The English Language Learner(ELL) subgroup made significant progress moving from 1.6% to 4.8% proficient. This still leaves this subgroup in the 'Critical Needs' category.

It was discussed that with the Land Trust funds we should look at the data for the area of greatest need. Based on the data the committee agreed the ELL was the group of greatest need.

Kathe proposed two ideas, first to have the funds go toward a STEM teacher and the second was having the funds go toward an intervention teacher.

Mary proposed using it for Art since that is the direction the school will be going in over the next few years. Heidi expressed concern in being able to score or collect data from art to show if it is helping in any way.

After discussion many felt the best way to reach the area of greatest need or ELL was through intervention. Cammy motioned to vote for using the Land Trust funds to cover an intervention teacher, Greg seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all in attendance unanimously voted for using the land trust funds for an intervention teacher.

The meeting was then adjourned.
