

Dear Parents,

Heading into the winter months with the potential for rain and snow, we want to make sure our curbside meal service remains safe. To maintain proper food temperatures and to help keep everyone safe in the meal delivery and pickup process, we are implementing some minor changes.

Beginning Monday, November 2, 2020, parents who normally pick up meals 'curbside' will be asked to park and then walk to a designated meal service door at the school to receive meals from 10 – 11 a.m.

This change will take place at our three current 'curbside' meal service locations:

- Joel P. Jensen Middle School
- Elkridge Middle School
- South Hills Middle School

This meal pick-up process will also be in place if a school is closed and students transitioned from in-person to virtual learning for two weeks.

In addition, please be aware that meals will also be provided from a 'designated' meal service door at each elementary school on **Friday, November 6, 2020, when elementary schools are not in session**. Check with your individual school for the meal service time on this day.

***Serving times may vary from school to school, so please check with your school for individual site serving times and the location of your designated meal service door.**
