

## Combined PTA/SCC Meeting Minutes April 1, 2022

In attendance: Ms. Johansen, Heidi Hansen, Rebecca Schaefer, Rosa Tecalco, Sarah Wright

### SCC

- Ms. Johansen talked about plans for the Battle of the Books competition next year. She asked the PTA for help paying for the books for the participants. PTA agreed to include a budget for this in next year's budget plan.
- Ms. Johansen mentioned that she may have some carryover money from this year's Title 1 budget. Potential uses include piano lab aide, .5 FTE for intervention, and afterschool program staffing.
- Sarah mentioned that it would be useful for parents to know the schedule for our parent evenings in advance to allow families to plan their evenings/leave work on time. Ms. Johansen agreed that a brief general schedule could be included in the email that goes home inviting families.
- The piano lab is close to being ready. We are currently working on approval and training for the app that will be used as a teaching resource.
- The Spring Soiree is scheduled for the evening of May 12.

### PTA

- The election results for next year's PTA Board are: Heidi Hansen as Continuing President, Sarah Wright as Incoming Secretary, and Lisa Blodgett as Continuing Treasurer.
- Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week is May 2-6. We discussed the idea of one big item, like a staff T-shirt, but due to turnover, decided small daily items would be better. We will do chips, drinks, candy popcorn, and chocolate candies for the first 4 days. We will discuss the possibility of a bigger treat/item on the last

day of the week. Rosa had seen some cute items at Walmart, Ms. Johansen suggested warm cookies, and Jenny suggested a cheesecake bar. Total budget for the week is \$400.

- We discussed the upcoming Field Day. The table at Art Night had several people volunteer to help with this. Ideas we agreed upon include:
  - 7 total rotations (snack will be a double rotation)
  - Activities will be parachute volleyball (2 parachutes/sheets, beach ball), jump the river (2 jump ropes), in and out (foam balls/bean bags, lots of hula hoops), water bucket relay (4 big buckets, 2 big cups, yard stick), over-under ball/wet ball pass with hula hoop challenge (2 balls, 2 buckets, 2 big hula hoops).
  - Snacks will be snow cones for everyone at 1 station, churros and popcorn for "purchase" with scan tickets. Tattoos are also available for "purchase". PTA will provide tickets for teachers to distribute to those who have "purchased" them. Sarah and Rosa will bring awnings. Mrs. Johansen will contact Cinemark about donating popcorn.
  - Rebecca and Heidi will check the PTA closet for supplies and gather those we still need. Rebecca will put together a rotation schedule, a map of rotations, and make rotation signs.
