  - i. Income -\$661.95

  - ii. Expenses \$2862
    1. Most of our expenses were a \$2100 grant to the school to pay for \$300 of bussing for field trips for each grade.

### **3. Council and Region Meeting Notes**

- a. Region Meeting 11/6/25
  - i. There is a public school board meeting on Tuesday to discuss boundary changes in west West Jordan (Copper Hills HS area) and in Riverton.
  - ii. The district is also looking for feedback on Parent Square.
    1. The district is exploring adding features to parent square, including virtual permission forms.
  - iii. The district will soon be blocking youtube on school chromebooks
    1. They found a way for teachers to show specific videos from youtube, without giving students access to youtube completely
  - iv. iBoss is a new app for parents to track/limit their students' chromebooks outside school hours (for secondary students who bring their chromebooks home)
