    - v. Kim asked for judging help – judging during fall break or the week after. Sarah will reach out to schools for a swap with 5 Majestic judges

  - c. Spirit Week
    - i. Sarah called for spirit week Chair – Stephanie volunteered as chair
      - 1. Stephanie asked safety to be a part of Spirit Week. Marianne suggested Beat the Street theme – neon day
      - 2. Treats for everyone that participates
