1. Pledge and Welcome led by Heidi Hansen.
2. Greg gave finance report: 19 memberships and \$10 donation for income.
3. We received a Safe Walking route packet, we will check with Kathe about what the school is doing for that.
4. PTA is providing teacher dinners on November 12th. Cammy is overseeing the dinners. She will be setting up in the break room at 3:00pm on the 12th and have everything ready for pickup by teachers at 3:20pm.
 - a. The office has given Cammy information for the 35 dinners we need we will plan on extra just to make sure everyone is covered.

 - c. We need to also watch minimum sales requirements to make sure we aren't left with a lot of unsold product.
